

- 3<sup>rd</sup> area - The Holy Spirit convicts unbelievers through the presence of Him in God's people, us.

- ① Jesus tells us we are God's lights in a dark world. Where we shine God's light, through words + actions, we chase away the darkness and illuminate sin. - **Matt 5:14-16**
- ② As we live out the Gospel and speak out God's word, people come to see their sin and need for Forgiveness - **Luke 19:1-10**
- ③ Some people will feel a sense of guilt + conviction of their sins in the presence of the Holy Spirit in believers - **Luke 23:39-43**

- 4<sup>th</sup> area - The Holy Spirit communicates through us to others.

- ① Enables us to understand and proclaim the Gospel - **Acts 2:14-41**
  - ② Helps us to teach others about scripture - **Acts 8:30-35**
  - ③ As we put our faith into action, as we live as Jesus taught us to - shining lights in the darkness and loving one another - we communicate God's will for the world and us. - **Acts 2:42-47**
- What does all this mean? We partner with the Holy Spirit to do God's work. God chooses to use us, to communicate the Gospel, to show the world He "light" and to show others the need to recognize their sin, confess it, receive new life and purpose through receiving the Holy Spirit, grow the Church, and prepare for coming again of Christ when He will make our new heaven and new earth, with us as adopted sons + daughters of God - His heirs sealed by His Spirit - for all eternity.
